## Legislative Consent Agenda.

- 1. Any resolution (or substitute resolution) that sustains a passing vote by at least nine-tenths (90%) of the voting legislative committee members in attendance shall be placed on the Legislative Consent Agenda.
- 2. All resolutions placed on the Legislative Consent Agenda shall be considered as a collective group by the Grand Council delegates, whose consideration of the Legislative Consent Agenda shall not be subject to debate, amendment, or substitution.
- 3. Notwithstanding #2, any resolution may be removed from the Legislative Consent Agenda by a vote of the majority of the Grand Council delegates at the time of the vote. Any resolution, upon being removed from the Legislative Consent Agenda, shall be considered as an ordinary item of business at the appropriate upcoming business session.
- 4. The Legislative Consent Agenda will be distributed to the Grand Council delegates no later than one hour before the interim business session.

## Adopted resolutions.

- 5. All adopted resolutions from the Legislative Consent Agenda shall be published in the Grand Council minutes along with those passed in the business sessions as specified in the Phi Delta Chi Constitution.
- 6. Except as specified elsewhere, all resolutions adopted by the Grand Council delegates shall be effective at the close of the final business session.
