GRAND COUNCIL 2023: REGISTRATION OPEN!



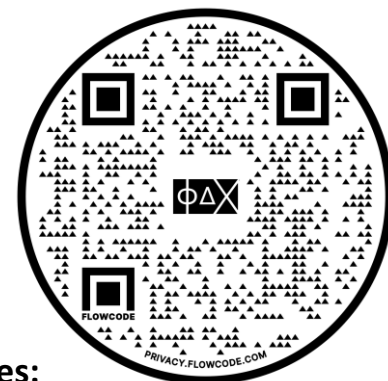

Policy Development Committee Meetings will be held pre-Grand Council this year.

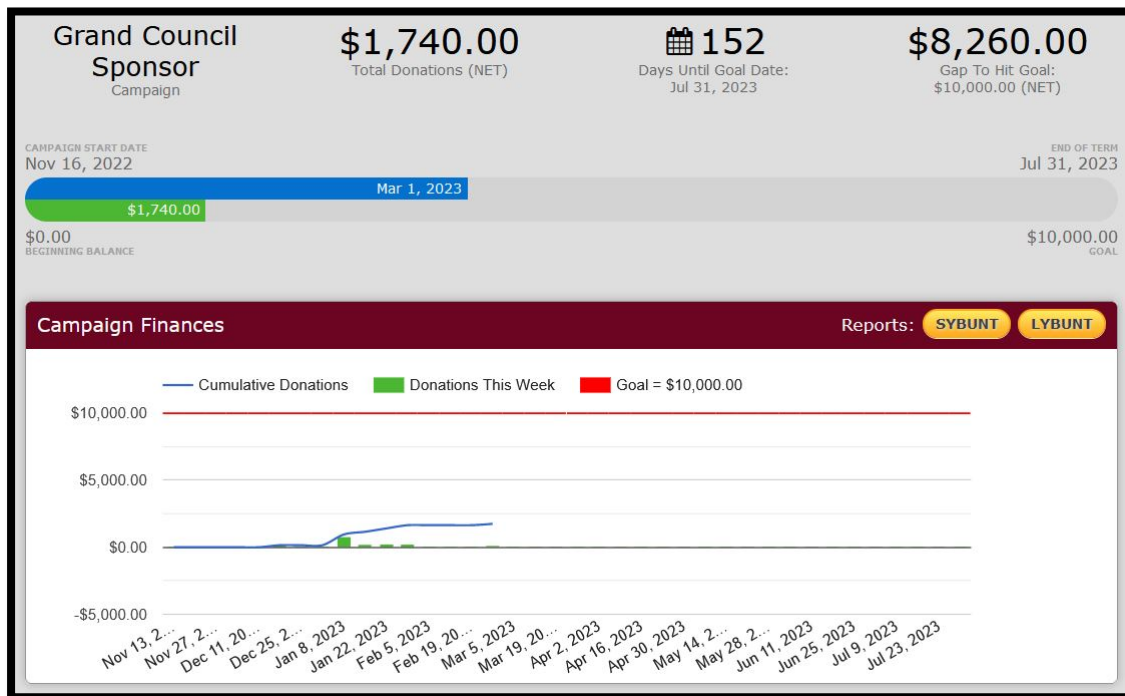
Register by June to have the opportunity to be selected to attend the meetings in July.

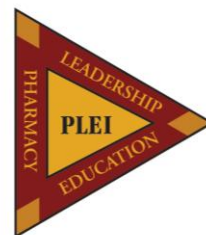

SCHLEGEL LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT AWARD: Call for Nominees

Thanks to the generosity of Alpha Psi alumnus Jack Schlegel and his wife, Priscilla, the Pharmacy Leadership & Education Institute (PLEI) will present the second Schlegel Leadership Development Award at the 74th Grand Council in Houston, Texas, in August 2023.

PLEI is the nonprofit foundation that Phi Delta Chi formed in 1996.

The John F. ("Jack") Schlegel Leadership Development Award will award a \$1,000 honorarium annually to a collegiate Brother of $\Phi\Delta\chi$ concluding his or her final professional year of study in spring 2023. The honoree must demonstrate the potential for exceptional leadership in the profession through exemplary behaviors and actions as a student and professional in training that gain the respect of peers.

Each collegiate Chapter of $\Phi\Delta\chi$ may submit one nomination. The deadline for receiving nominations is May 25, 2023.

To be considered, each Nomination Packet should contain: (a) a Personal Data Form, (b) a personal statement not to exceed 500 words in which the nominee expresses a vision of what he or she aspires to accomplish within 10 years after graduation, and

(c) three letters of recommendation that address the nominee's potential for exceptional leadership in the profession after graduation. One of the letters must come from the Chapter Advisor.

The PLEI Board of Directors will determine the honoree. In establishing the award, Jack noted that many student pharmacists are so focused on working their way through their educational program that they do not have time to take on formal leadership positions with organizations, but instead demonstrate their potential by exhibiting leadership in other than elected positions. He distinctly wishes all forms of leadership to be considered in this award. The pathway for submitting nomination packets starts at <https://plei.org/schlegel/>.

The first recipient of the Schlegel Leadership Development Award was Courtney Purcell, PharmD, alumnus of the Omega Chapter at University of Tennessee Health Science Center.

LONG RANGE RETREAT UPDATE FROM GRAND PRESIDENT- ANDREA BOURQUE

Brothers,

The 2015-2017 Executive Council took a new path for development in 2016 and began a process for implementing 5-year long range goals for our organization. Back in 2016 the first of our Long Range Strategic Planning Retreat was held in Washington, DC. The results of that retreat were three main ideas for our organization to focus on for the next 5 years. From that retreat there were three top overarching goals created.

Our strategy focuses on three key goals:

Goal #1: Double the number of engaged alumni. This goal focused on how to engage our alumni while maintaining our commitment to collegiate Brothers. In essence, we need to understand and communicate what it means to be Brothers for life. Alumni engagement is critical to our success as an organization. We talked about the importance of delivering programs and experiences tailored to all the stages of brothers' lives.

Goal #2: Build a robust national network of collegiate and alumni chapters. This goal focused on building a national network of alumni chapters while working to bring our collegiate chapters up to high standards. Our collegiate Brothers have a home in student chapters; we want to establish exciting alumni chapters in strategic locations that engage our Brothers for the rest of their lives.

Goal #3: Build a strong, agile infrastructure to support growth. This goal focused on creating and providing the infrastructure needed to support the Brotherhood. This includes aligning PLEI to add value to the Brotherhood.

Looking back, our goals were very heavily focused on the needs of our alumni Brothers and the overall experiences throughout our Brotherhood life-cycle. With the unforeseen experiences of a global pandemic and changes in the pharmacy school climate, it was time for a revamp to our goals and strategies.

I am pleased to announce that in January of this year we held our second Long Range Strategic Planning Retreat. This retreat was actually way overdue, but due to COVID restrictions, the Executive Council thought it best to wait until now. A diverse and equal representation of both collegiate and alumni Brothers met over three days to discuss our current status and the future of our organization. Within the next few weeks, we will be releasing Phi Delta Chi's 2023-2028 Strategic Plan.
