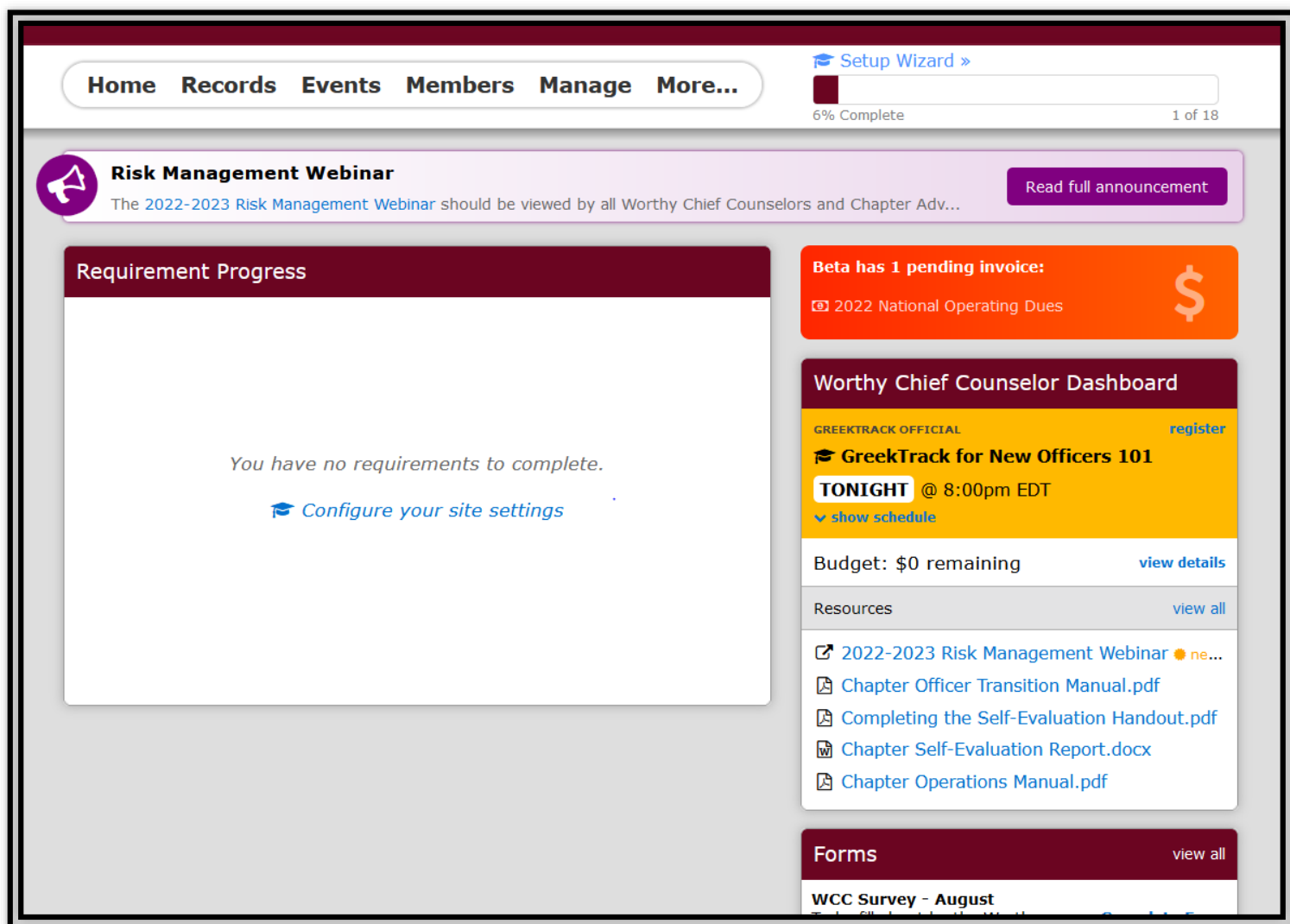




## NEW CHAPTER MANAGEMENT SYSTEM: GREEKTRACK

## ACCEPTING NOMINATIONS

The Albert B. Prescott  
Pharmacy Leadership  
Award



It is with great pleasure that the Pharmacy Leadership and Education Institute (PLEI) announces that nominations for the 2023 Albert B. Prescott Pharmacy Leadership Award, sponsored by Phi Lambda Sigma, are now open.

The Albert B. Prescott Pharmacy Leadership Award, first presented in 1987, is given annually to a young pharmacist no more than 10 years after receipt of their PharmD. The PLEI Albert B. Prescott Leadership Award recognizes outstanding leadership.

The 2023 Prescott recipient, who must have received his or her PharmD in 2013 or later, will receive a \$2,000 honorarium. He or she must give an address during the 2023 American Pharmacists Association annual meeting in Phoenix, AZ (March 24-27, 2023) and prepare a text based on the address that is suitable for publication in the Journal of the American Pharmacists Association.

We invite you to nominate a young pharmacist for this award. Self-nominations are also permitted. Nominations may be submitted online via the following website: <https://plei.org/prescott/>. **Nomination materials include:**

1. Curriculum vitae (CV) of the nominee
2. Letter of nomination
3. Supporting letters of recommendation (up to 5 will be accepted)
4. Nomination materials must be received by November 4, 2022. Late submissions/letters will not be considered.
