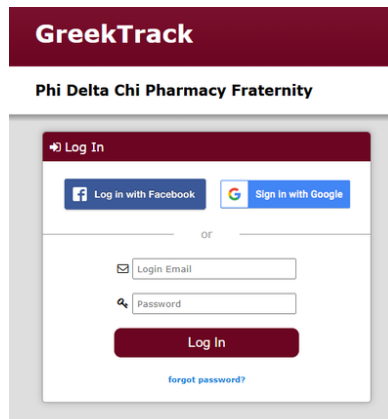
APPLICATIONS OPEN FOR ST. JUDE LIAISON
